

CVOP 2024 Call for Abstracts

The first annual meeting of the Consortium of Vision and Oculomics in Psychiatry (CVOP) will be held in Rochester, NY from Thursday, July 11, 2024 through Friday, July 12, 2024. This will be an in-person conference only.

We look forward to receiving submissions for presentations on a wide range of topics at the intersection of vision science and psychiatry. Submissions may include talks or posters reporting on completed studies or works in progress. The Program Committee strongly encourages submissions from women, underrepresented minorities, and early-career scientists. We encourage submissions reporting findings relevant to diverse mental health conditions, diverse topics and methods within vision science (including retinal measurements, visual psychophysics, neuroimaging, EEG, etc.). We also welcome both human and animal work.

Abstracts will be accepted via the online submission portal, which open now and can be accessed here: https://www.cvop.org/cvop-2024. The due date to submit all presentation types is **February 28th, 2024 at 5:00 pm MT**.



Membership and Submissions

Submissions must come from CVOP members. All members (Full, Associate, Student) are encouraged to submit. Membership is free, and you can submit an application here.

Presentation Formats

Formats available include posters and individual talks. The Program Committee will select oral presentations and posters based on the quality of submissions, the diversity of presenters, and the balance of content in the overall conference program. Submissions not accepted for oral presentation may be considered for presentation as individual posters at the author's request. The first author is expected to give the oral presentation or present the poster.

Oral Presentations: Submissions accepted for oral presentations will be organized by the Program Committee into sessions that generally include 4 to 6 talks (~15 minutes per talk and several minutes for questions) and time for questions. When submitting your abstract, you will also be asked if you would like your talk to be considered as a Poster.

<u>Posters:</u> Submissions for poster-only may include presentations of works in progress (e.g., studies for which data collection is well under way, but for which full results are not yet available).

Submission Format: Submissions will be accepted by website. In general, each individual abstract should not exceed 250 words.

Number of Submissions per Member: There is no limit to the number of submissions on which a CVOP Member may be an author. However, members may only be first author on one oral submission and one poster submission.

Submission Withdrawals: If it is necessary to withdraw a submission, please notify the Program Chair as soon as possible.

Other Notes: Please note that CE credits will not be available for the 2024 meeting.
