Submissions

All submitted papers will undergo a rigorous double-blind peer review process by an expert panel of reviewers. Submissions will be evaluated based on their originality, significance, technical quality, and clarity of presentation. The categories are:

- Full research papers, 10-12 pages.
- Short papers, 4-6 pages long.
- Case studies and applications paper, 4-6 pages long.
- Industry papers, 4-6 pages long.
- Session Proposal, 1 page abstract.
