

Seminars/Workshops

The seminars/workshops have a key objective of initiating interactions among scientists and technologists from India & France and are expected to result in Industry-Academia & Academia-Academia centric collaborations.

Areas

CSRP:

- **Health:** One Health & Climate Change, Early detection of emerging/important pathogens, Developments of new vaccines and therapeutics for infectious diseases, AI for early diagnosis of emerging/important diseases, Comprehensive studies on metabolic and cardiovascular diseases and Novel therapeutics and biological for emerging/important diseases.
- **Marine Sciences:** Underwater Systems, Instrumentation & Robotics, Advanced Materials for Floating and Mobile Systems, Geosciences from the Coast to Deep Waters, Physics and Biochemistry of Oceans, Oceans Observations & Modeling including the Ocean & Climate Nexus, Ocean & Climate and Marine Biology & Pollution.

IARDP:

- Renewable & Clean Energy, Health Care, Smart Mobility, Technology for the SDGs (including Marine Sciences), Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning, Waste Management & Circular Economy, Agricultural Science and Technology, Sustainable Nutrition

Eligibility

- Support is exclusively available to full time faculty/scientists and PhD's researchers affiliated with esteemed universities in India and France.
- A minimum of 5 scientists from each country must be physically present at the seminar, with total participation expected to include 25–30 participants from different institutions in both countries.

Additional eligibility for Industry - Academia Seminars/workshops

For Industry-Academia seminars/workshops, industry participation is must (physical joining)

Duration

2-5 days

Funding

- ~€25.000(for seminar/workshop in France) and Rs.20 lakhs (for seminar/workshop in India)
- Financial support is provided for travel, accommodation, and logistics. Major contributors (e.g., presenters, workshop leaders) will receive travel support.
- Co-funding from industry shall be encouraged.
